

2009-2010 Hellman Family Awards for Early Career Faculty Announcement

Thirteen UCSF faculty members have won the distinguished 2009 "Hellman Family Awards for Early-Career Faculty". The Hellman Award provides support to outstanding faculty members at the Assistant Professor level, who have demonstrated promise and creativity in their research or other scholarly activities. This year's selection committee was composed of faculty members from the Basic Science and Clinical Health Science community, and chaired by Emily von Scheven, MD, Associate Professor in Pediatrics.

The committee received over 60 applications for new and continuation applications for awards ranging from \$25,000-45,000. The proposals submitted by our outstanding junior faculty were competitively selected for their originality, promise of distinction, and need of further funding support.
